Add this activity to your story time.

Supplies:

- Paper plate
- Construction paper
- Brown and black markers
- Popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Glue

Read: *Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you See?*

Activity:

- Children love to interact with story times. Feel free to ask them lots of questions about the pictures in the book, the colors, their opinions, and what they think is happening/going to happen in the story.
- Cut the paper plate in half and cut holes for the eyes.
- Let your child color the paper plate brown (or any color!).
- Cut ears out of construction paper and glue onto the mask.
- Glue a popsicle stick on the bottom to hold the mask.
