



THE MIXED UP CHAMELEON

At Home Edition - #MCMAtHome

Add this activity to your story time.

Supplies:

- Two paper plates
- Scissors
- Paint
- Brass fastener

Read: *The Mixed up Chameleon*

Activity:

- Children love to interact with story times. Feel free to ask them lots of questions about the pictures in the book, the colors, their opinions, and what they think is happening/going to happen in the story.
- Cut a chameleon shape from one of the paper plates.
- Have your child paint the second plate with lots of colors.
- Once the paint is dry, lay the plate with the chameleon on top of the painted one.
- When you turn the top plate, the chameleon will change colors!

Alternative:

- Use a sharpie to draw a chameleon shape on a sandwich bag.
- Put a few drops of paint into the bag.
- Let your child squish the paint around in the bag, changing the chameleon's colors.
