Add this activity to your story time.

Supplies:

- Paper plate
- Hole punch
- Yarn
- Pipe cleaners OR construction paper

Read: *The Very Busy Spider*

Activity:

- Children love to interact with story times. Feel free to ask them lots of questions about the pictures in the book, the colors, their opinions, and what they think is happening/going to happen in the story.
- Before doing this activity, punch holes around the edge of the paper plate, about an inch from the rim of the plate.
- Give your child yarn and show them how to thread it through the holes to make a spider web on the plate.
- Make a spider out of pipe cleaners or construction paper to go in your spider web.
