Add this activity to your story time.

Supplies:

- Construction paper
- Paper plate
- Glue
- Pipe cleaners

Read: *The Very Quiet Cricket*

Activity:

- Children love to interact with story times. Feel free to ask them lots of questions about the pictures in the book, the colors, their opinions, and what they think is happening/going to happen in the story.
- Help your children cut out a head, and legs for their cricket from construction paper.
- Cut the paper plate in half and paint it green for his body.
- Attach the cricket's legs and head to the paper plate with glue.
- You can use paint for his eyes, and pipe cleaners for his antenna.
- If pipe cleaners aren't available, you can create the antenna from construction paper.
