Meridian, Miss. (March 28, 2023) – On Tuesday, March 28th, representatives from Molina Healthcare of Mississippi presented the Mississippi Children's Museum – Meridian (MCM-Meridian) with a \$35,000 contribution to sponsor the museum's *Happy Healthy Families* program for the second year in a row.

Taking place in the Summer of 2023, this four-part family program series aims to empower participating caregivers and children to make healthy choices by providing them with the tools, skills, and resources needed to put them on a path toward lifelong wellness.

MCM-Meridian, with the support of Molina Healthcare, will engage 25 families through a partnership with the Meridian Housing Authority to participate in a 4-session program that focuses on improving the social/emotional wellness, health/nutrition, and healthy physical habits of the participating children and families. Literacy will be a foundational piece of this programming with each family receiving one children's book per session that relates to the program topics.

The participants will complete a pre- and post- survey to indicate any changes in family health/nutrition, social/emotional wellness, physical activity and literacy attitudes and behaviors during the life of the program.

The dates for the program are June 13, June 27, July 11, and July 18 from 4:30-6:30pm. A light supper will be provided to the 25 participating families from 4:30pm - 5:00pm before programming takes place from 5:00pm - 6:30pm.
