# The Mississippi Children's Museum – Meridian Announces New Exhibit, Celebrations: Asian Culture

A new exhibit is set to open at the Mississippi Children's Museum – Meridian on August 4<sup>th</sup>.

Meridian, Miss. (July 11, 2023) – The Mississippi Children's Museum – Meridian (MCM-Meridian) is thrilled to announce the opening of *Celebrations: Asian Culture*, a modular exhibit from the Freeman Foundation created to help children learn about and understand Asian cultures. *Celebrations: Asian Culture* will be available at the museum from August 4 – November 3 and January 9 – February 16.

Celebrations: Asian Culture is designed to bring children and families together to explore New Year celebrations in South Korea, China, and Vietnam through the imagery of fireworks, lanterns, lotuses, and kites. Children can participate in activities such as drumming, dancing, and storytelling. From telling the Nian Monster story in a small theater to discovering different dishes served for breakfast as an eye spy game, children will be captivated by the rich history, beauty, and fun of these Asian New Year festivals.

Museum members will be some of the first guests to experience this new exhibit. On **Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>**, MCM-Meridian will host an exclusive **Members-Only Preview Night** from 5-7pm before opening to the public on Friday, August 4th. Additional events and programs tied to the exhibit will take place throughout the fall and winter.

Over the past twenty years, the Freeman Foundation has majorly invested in developing a greater appreciation of Asian cultures and histories in the United States, in partnership with the Association of Children's Museums (ACM). As a hands-on, modular exhibit, *Celebrations: Asian Culture* will help visitors to deeply engage with the content. By remaining at MCM-Meridian and in the community, this exhibit will become a part of a child's long-term memory, creating a more in-depth experience, openness, and comprehension of Asian cultures.
