C Spire's C3 Jr Coding Challenge Kicks Off MS Science Fest

Jackson, Miss. (Sept. 19, 2023) – On Thursday, 20 teams from across the state participated in C Spire's C3 Jr Coding Challenge at the Mississippi Children's Museum in Jackson and Meridian.

C3 Jr is a coding challenge uniquely designed for elementary age students to learn 21st century technology skills. Teams comprised of four fourth grade students were guided through coding challenges by a C Spire Mentor, treated to lunch compliments of C Spire, and participated in an awards ceremony at the conclusion of the challenge.

During the challenge, teams used critical thinking and problem-solving skills to design an obstacle course and code a robot to complete the course. Awards were given to team members who showed an awesome attitude, team spirit, creative thinking, and problem-solving skills during the challenge. The top three teams received trophies and tech-related prizes.
