The Mississippi Children's Museum – Meridian Celebrates Careers in STEAM During Science Saturday Event

Meridian, Miss. (August 25, 2023) — MCM-Meridian is hosting its third annual Science Saturday event presented by NSPARC and held in conjunction with the Mississippi Science Festival (MSF) presented by C Spire! These events aim to create excitement around STEAM education in children across the state.

During Science Saturday, children and families are invited to engage with STEAM leaders and explore potential careers in Mississippi. From 10am to 3pm, various organizations will showcase their industry and work through unique exhibits, allowing guests to interact and learn from them.

In the days leading up to Science Saturday, MCM-Meridian will host two additional events designed for elementary students and their chaperones:

- September 14: C Spire C3 Jr. Coding Challenge Twenty schools from across the state have been invited to the Mississippi Children's Museum in Jackson and Meridian to participate in C3 Jr, a coding challenge uniquely designed for elementary age students. Teams comprised of four fourth grade students will be guided through coding challenges by a C Spire Mentor, treated to lunch compliments of C Spire, and participate in an awards ceremony at the conclusion of the challenge.
- September 15: Field Trip Friday An interactive field trip day where students can meet STEAM professionals and engage with their exhibits.

This year's exhibitors for Field Trip Friday and Science Saturday include various groups from Mississippi State University, as well as BLOOM Sustainable Materials, EMEPA, Meridian Symphony Association, MDOT, the Raider Robotics team at Lamar School, and NAS Meridian.

Science Saturday will take place on September 16 from 10 am to 3 pm. All activities are included in general admission (\$10/person) and museum membership. Tickets can be purchased online or at the door. For more information, visit www.mcmmeridian.org.
