MCM achieves this goal not only through hosting family literacy and STEAM programming and events throughout the year, but also through Launch into Learning, MCM's afterschool program. In partnership with Jackson Public Schools, MCM hosts both grant-funded and tuition-based students from McWillie Elementary, Obama Magnet Elementary, and Wells APAC. Now in its third year, Launch into Learning has not only contributed to an overall improvement in students' academic performance but has also garnered praise from 88% of careaivers, who report that their children are more engaged in their schoolwork since participating in MCM's afterschool program.
