

Facilities and Grounds Associate

Summary: The Facilities and Grounds Associate provides support for the maintenance, cleanliness, and efficient operation of the museum. This position serves as the Lead Facilities Department Associate on the floor who assists and performs activities to ensure the museum is maintained and is ready for daily operations, facility rental, museum events or any other tasks deemed necessary by the Facilities and Exhibits Manager. This is a full-time position that reports directly to the Facilities and Exhibits Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Serves as Lead Facilities Associate on the floor.
- Maintains MCM janitorial housekeeping standards.
- Opens and closes on weekends and on weekdays, if needed.
- Sets up and resets after facility rental and museum events.
- Assists with exhibits installation and maintenance.
- Responds to Facilities and Exhibits Departments calls over walkie talkie.
- Maintains parking lot cleanliness.
- Sweeps, rakes, and blows Literacy Garden porch and pathways.
- Learns and assists with maintenance and repair of permanent exhibits in museum.
- Works with contract cleaning service to achieve the highest standards in cleanliness for the museum.
- Notifies management concerning needs for major repairs and additions.
- Provides maintenance support to the Facilities and Exhibits Manager.
- Monitors use of consumables (toilet paper, paper towels, light bulbs, etc.).
- Sweeps, mops, scrubs, and vacuums hallways, stairs, bathrooms, museum galleries and office space. Trash removal, as necessary.
- Works with the Facilities and Exhibits Manager on miscellaneous tasks, as assigned.
