

Guest Services Associate - Seasonal

This individual must provide exceptional service in daily, extensive face-to-face contact with museum guests at the Guest Services Desk, Gift Shop and Café. This is a part time, seasonal position requiring approximately 25 hours. The Guest Services Associate reports directly to the Assistant Director of Operations.

Principal Accountabilities:

- Sells tickets, memberships and retail products when providing support at the Guest Services Desk, Gift Shop and Cafe
- Provides hospitality to children and their caregivers by greeting each visitor, offering information, answering questions, and providing general assistance
- Uses point-of-sale system to sell products to customers, including admission tickets, memberships, and gift shop items
- Balances cash drawers at end of shift and follows cash handling procedures

Responsibilities and Duties

Front Desk:

- Greets Customers
- Sells admission tickets to guests
- Answers phones
- Answers guest questions
- Assists the Assistant Director of Operations with the selling and processing of memberships

Retail:

- Greets Customers
- Sells museum store products to guests and visitors
- Replenishes bags and supplies for daily store operations
- Restocks empty sales displays
